## How to keep track of SHS uploads to My Health Record in Clinical Software



## General Practice Compliance to ePIP

For compliance to ePIP one of the requirements of general practices is to ensure they are uploading the required number of Shared Health Summaries (SHS) each PIP quarter to My Health Record (MHR) based on their Standard Whole Patient Equivalent (SWPE).

For practices that want to track their uploads to MHR, it can be achieved through the following methods.

Ensure the **correct date range** for the <u>ePIP</u> quarter is set.

- Medical Director: Use their tracking tool.
- Zedmed: Use their <u>"summary upload count report"</u>
- Best Practice:

From Management, select the 'Reports' tab, then select the 'Shared Health Summaries – Uploaded' report.

Another option is to go to Utilities > Search, and enter the below in the SQL Query box and click Run Query:

SELECT \* FROM BPS Patients bp

INNER JOIN PCEHRACCESS p ON bp.InternalID = p.InternalID

WHERE StatusText = 'Active'

AND p.SERVICE = 7

AND p.RESULT = 1

AND CAST(p.ACCESSDATE as date) BETWEEN '20160101' AND '20160201'

ORDER BY surname, firstname

Note: edit dates in YYYYMMDD format

- **Genie:** not available within software (Pen CAT is compatible with Genie).
- Pen CAT: Use their SHS upload recipe.
