## Walrus Walkthrough

### Step 1

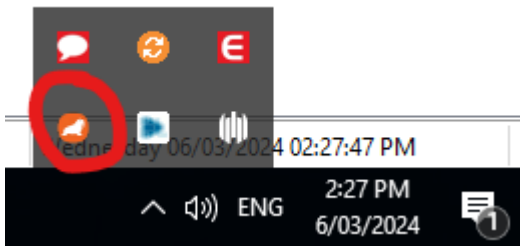
**Login to Walrus** using your POLAR credentials.

Haven't downloaded Walrus to your PC yet? Follow the [instructions here](#).

### Step 2

When viewing the patient file, navigate to the Walrus window.

If Walrus is not showing, you can locate the Walrus application as seen below in the "show hidden icons" tab (refer back to *Walrus Instructions to configure Walrus to always show on your screen by default*).

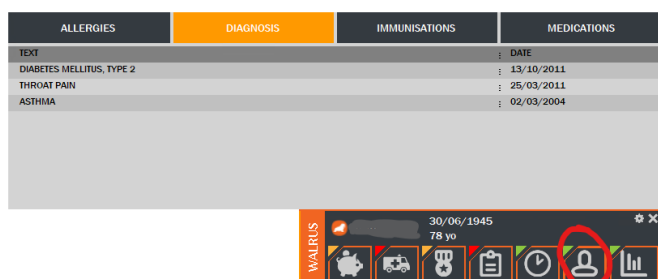


### Step 3

Select the "Patient Clinic Summary" icon to view information about the patients' allergies, diagnosis, medications, immunisations.

Identify patients with these diagnoses:

- Diabetes
- Stable ischaemic heart disease
- Anxiety or depression
- COPD
- Chronic pain
- Osteoarthritis



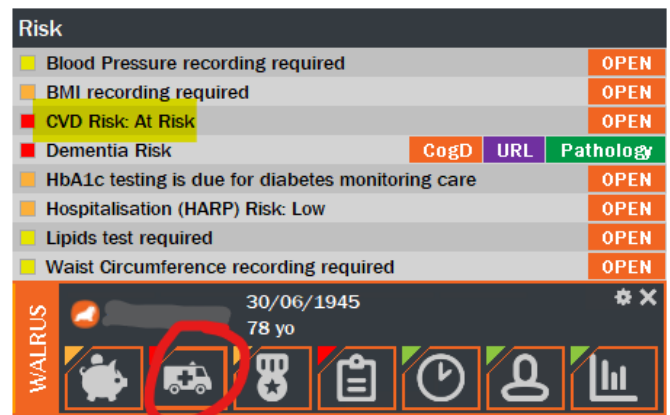
### Step 4

**Or**

Select the "Risk" icon to view patient risk categories.

Identify patient with these risk categories:

- AusDRisk Category – High
- Risk Category for CVD – At Risk
