



POLAR WALKTHROUGH

Identifying RACGP active and practice active patients With certain quality measures recorded

This activity guides practices to identify RACGP active patients (have attended the clinic at least three times in the last 2 years), and practice active patients (those marked as active in clinical software) that have certain quality measures recorded such as allergies, smoking status and BMI.

<p>Login to POLAR, and navigate to 'Reports',</p> <p>selecting the 'Clinic Summary'</p>	
<p>Under the 'Filters' on the left,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> click 'Patient', select 'Active' under Patient Status, and give it a tick. Select 'Active' under RACGP Active, and give it a tick

You can check you have the right filters on by checking the filters bar.

You should now be able to view your patient count to see how many patients are both RACGP Active and Practice Active
