


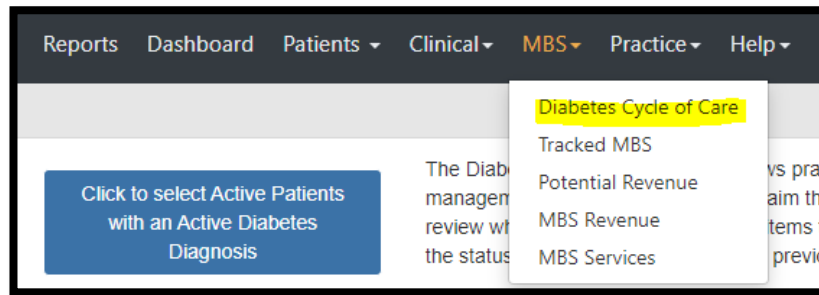
Identifying RACGP and practice active patients

with an active diagnosis of diabetes and review their care quality

This activity guides practices to identify RACGP and practice active patients who have an active diagnosis of diabetes and review whether they have had certain routine care measures completed in the last 12 months (e.g. blood tests and BMI recorded).

<p>Login to POLAR, and navigate to 'Reports',</p> <p>selecting the 'Clinic Summary'</p>	
<p>Under the 'Filters' on the left,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• click 'Patient',• select 'Active' under Patient Status, and give it a tick.• Select 'Active' under RACGP Active, and give it a tick	

Hover over the 'MBS' Reports and select 'Diabetes Cycle of Care' Report.



Now click the button that states "Click to select Active Patients with an Active Diabetes Diagnosis".

The Diabetes Cycle of Care page allows practices to track the items relating to an annual diabetes cycle of care management for diabetic patients to claim the MBS rebate. Practices can select items as a group on the summary table, review which patients have 1 or more items to complete for their cycle and review individual patients needed activities on the status table. All tables relate to the previous 12 month period

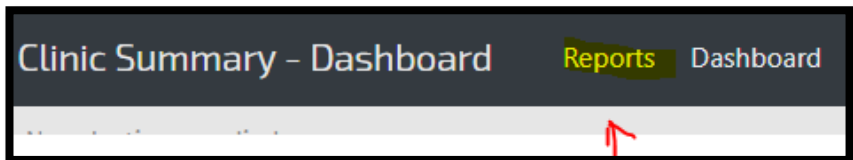

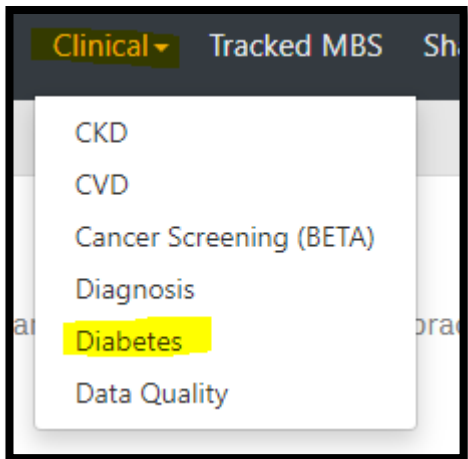

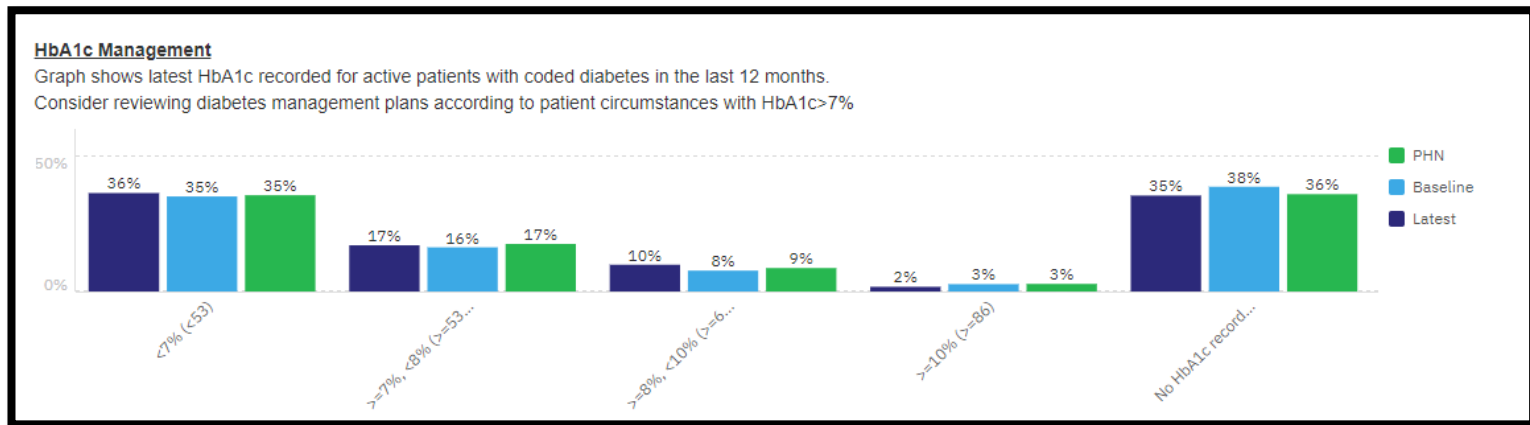
Click the 'Reports' button, and navigate to the QIPC Report.
